### **Competencies:**

**Second Language competency** in a single foreign language, either one of the following:

- 1. 3 years of one language in High School
- 2. Completion of level 3 in one language (for students who began a language in middle school)
- 3. Completion of intermediate level 2 (for students who have not completed 3 years of one language in high school) \*This rule only applies to students planning to enroll in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences or the School of Business
- 4. Completion of elementary level 2 (for students who have not completed 3 years of one language in high school) \* This rule applies to students planning to enroll in the Schools of Engineering, Fine Arts, Education, and the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources
