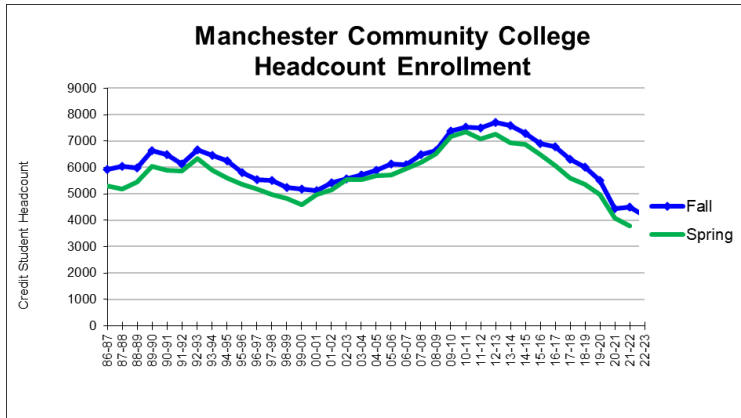
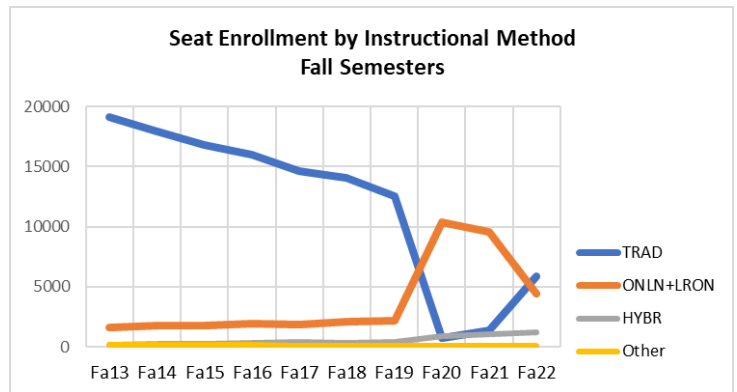
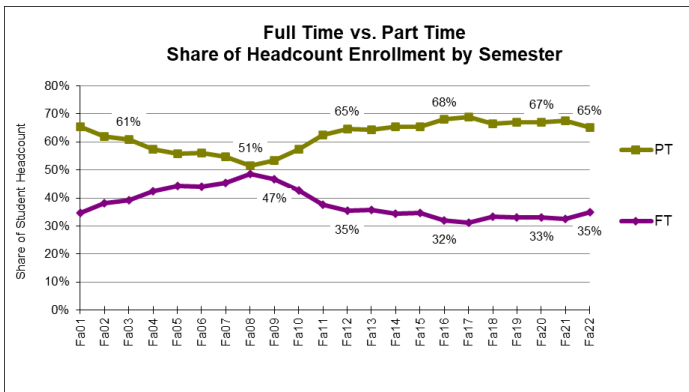


Manchester Community College Enrollment Update Fall 2022

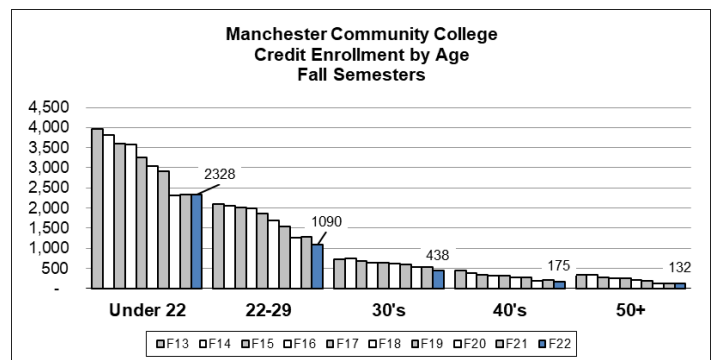
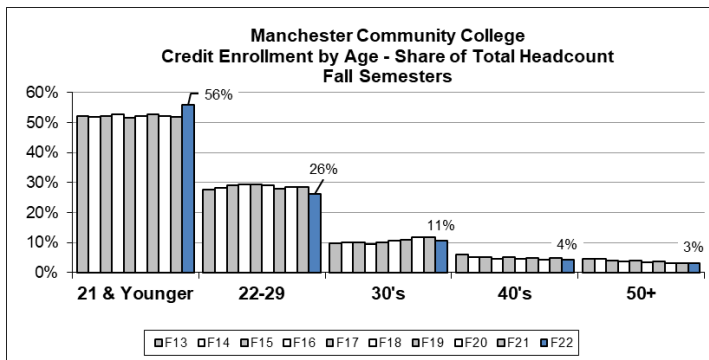
MCC's credit enrollment has been in decline for most of the past decade, as shown in the chart below. Fall 2022 credit headcount of 4,164 is down 7% vs Fa21, down 33% vs five years ago in Fa18, and down 46% vs our peak enrollment in Fa12.



The chart on the left shows the share of students registered full-time increased from 33% last year to 35% in Fa22. Most MCC students are registered PT with 11 or fewer credits. The chart on the right shows seat enrollment by instructional method. Online enrollment, shown as the orange line, increased dramatically in Fa20. For the ten years prior, traditional classes (blue line) had accounted for 80-90% of enrollment. In Fa22 about half of the credit seats are in traditional classes, almost 40% in online, and 10% in hybrid.



Over the past twenty years, traditional college-age students have accounted for about half of credit enrollment. The share of traditional age students increased from 52% in Fa21 to 56% this year. The number of traditional-age students is about the same as last year, but the number of students 22 or older decreased by 15% vs last year.



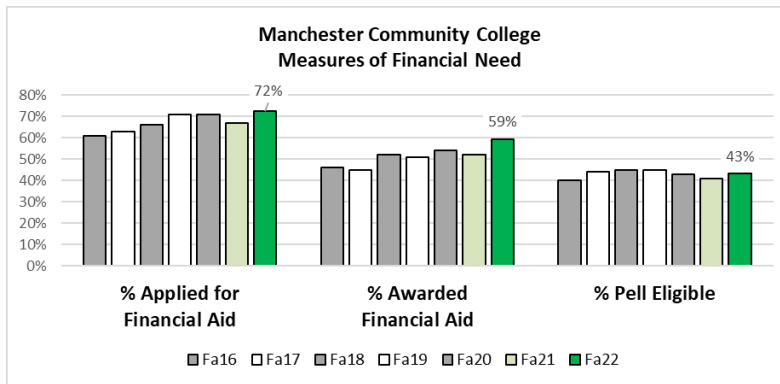

Several program groups increased enrollment vs. last year, including Allied Health Careers, Liberal Arts, Hospitality, Graphic Design and Visual Fine Arts.

More than half of the credit students apply for and are awarded federal, state or institutional financial aid, as shown in the chart below. Fa21 shows an increase on these metrics vs. Fa21. Forty-three percent of MCC's Fall 2022 credit students are eligible for Pell grants.



Among MCC's spring 2022 credit students that didn't graduate, 58% returned for Fall '22. In the chart below the gray and white columns are pre-pandemic spring-to-fall return rates; the yellow column represents our mostly online Sp20 to Fa20 rate; and the blue columns are the two most recent years. There is a slight increase in return rates Sp22 vs Sp21.
