



GRADUATION APPLICATION

INSTRUCTIONS

Potential graduates are strongly encouraged to submit an application the semester in which they are expected to graduate. Submit a separate application with each certificate and degree requested. If you miss the graduation deadline, your name may not be printed in the commencement program book

1. Please **complete section "A" only**. In order to expedite in the processing of your application, it is very important to fill out all the information. Make sure your name is **printed legibly** and is written exactly as you want it to appear on your degree and /or certificate. (See list of degree codes and majors attached to the application.) Once you have submitted the attached application and later decide to change your name there will be a \$20.00 charge to re-order a diploma with the changed name.
2. To have your degree and/or certificate conferred in **December**, the deadline for this application is, **October 15**. Should you miss the application deadline, your degree and/or certificate will be considered for the next graduation cycle. To receive your degree and/or certificate in **May** the deadline for this application is, **March 15** If you miss the graduation deadline or are **short (4 or less) credits** to graduate, your degree/certificate will not be ordered until all requirements have been met **and another application has been filled out**. You may request special permission to participate in the ceremony by filling out an **Appeals Form** no later than **May 10**. Appeal forms can be picked up at the Registrar's office. **Your name may not be printed in the commencement program book. ***To have your degree and/or certificate conferred in August, the deadline for this application is, July 15***** Should you miss the application deadline, your degree and/or certificate will be considered for the next graduation cycle.
3. The Registrar's office will notify all graduates regarding the result of their degree/certificate evaluation. All degrees and/or certificates **will be mailed** to your stated residence. 4. You may **mail, email, fax or drop off** your application(s) to the Registrar's Office. Our mailing address is P.O. Box 1046 MS#13, Manchester, CT 06045-1046 (**postmarked no later than October 15th, March 15th, or July 15th**), the fax number is (860)512-3221.
5. If you requested a **second degree**, you must complete a minimum of **15** credits beyond the number required for the initial degree, and fulfill all requirements of the second degree. You must submit a graduation application for each degree. **If you are requesting three degrees, permission from the Dean of Academic Affairs is required.**
6. All graduates and their guests are invited to attend the Commencement Exercises. All degrees and certificates are conferred August, December and May. Graduates **will be notified by e-mail** by early May when to pick up their invitations and caps/gowns, additional information pertaining to the Commencement Ceremony will be on the **MCC website** as it becomes available.
7. All official transcripts from courses taken at other institutions must be on file by the deadline given by the Registrar's Office. All candidates must follow graduation policy. Degrees will not be conferred if all the necessary paperwork is not on file.
