Plan ahead

- Make sure that you know two ways out of every building.
- Be familiar with the location of the alarm system pull stations and extinguishers.
- Be familiar with all gas shut-off outlet locations in laboratories.

When an Alarm is Sounded

- When an alarm is given to evacuate the building, leave the building immediately by the nearest marked exit and alert others to do the same.
- ➤ Keep calm; do not shout during any emergency.
- Do <u>not</u> question whether an alarm or warning is false or actual, simply evacuate.
- Do <u>not</u> utilize the phone system except to sound the alarm or report the location of mobility challenged individuals or casualties
- \blacktriangleright Do <u>not</u> use the elevator.
- Any individuals with limited mobility should be assisted in exiting the building or in getting to an enclosed stairwell.
 - ALL enclosed stairwells at Manchester Community College may be used as Areas of Refuge as they are constructed so as to maintain integrity against fire and smoke.
 - All stairwells will be checked by emergency personnel during an evacuation.
 - Remain at that location until the All Clear or until assistance arrives.
- Do <u>not</u> enter or return to an evacuated building unless told to do so by emergency personnel. Do <u>not</u> assume that because an audible alarm has been silenced, it means you can return to an evacuated building.
