Health	1	Take at SCSU
History of World Civilizations	3	HIS 101, 102
“L” Course (writing course)	9	Take at SCSU (transfer with 60+ credits, only need 2 “L” courses)
Literature	3	ENG 221, 222, 232, 262
Math	3-8	MAT 172 (no equivalent. at MCC) and MAT 230 or 250(254)
*Natural Sciences, Group A	3-6	BIO 121, 122, EAS 102, OCE 101, AST 101, GLG 121, <b>OR</b> both BIO 211 & 212
*Natural Science, Group B	3-4	CHE 111, 121, PHY121
*One natural science course <b>MUST</b> have a lab		
Philosophy	3	PHL 101, 111, 131, 151
Social Sciences A	3	ECN 101
Social Sciences B	3	ANT 101, 105, PSY 111, SOC 101, 201
