University Requirements for Connecticut Community College Transfers Majoring in Early Childhood Education

| Foreign Language | 3 | BS degree - second semester level required (FRE, ITA or SPA 102) BA degree – fourth semester level required (FRE, ITA or SPA 202) |
| Health | 1 | Take at SCSU |
| History of World Civilizations | 3 | HIS 101, 102 |
| “L” Course (writing intensive) | 9 | Take at SCSU (transfer with 60+ credits, only need 2 “L” courses) |
| Literature | 3 | ENG 221, 222, 232, 262 |
| Math | 3-4 | MAT 143 |
| *Natural Sciences, Group A | 3-6 | BIO 121, 122, EAS 102, OCE 101, AST 101, GLG 121, OR both BIO 211 & 212 |
| *Natural Science, Group B | 3-4 | CHE 111, 121, PHY 121 |
| *One natural science course MUST have a lab | | |
| Philosophy | 3 | Education majors take at SCSU |
| Social Sciences A | 3 | ECN 101, 102, GEO 101, POL 103, 111 |
| Social Sciences B | 3 | PSY 111 |
| Cognate (Take all courses listed) | | MAT (take at SCSU, no equivalent at MCC) and PSY 201 or 203 |

The chart is just a guide for using Connecticut Community College courses to complete University and Major Requirements for SCSU. There may be specific courses required to meet university requirements for a number of majors at SCSU. Use the SCSU catalog/web site to obtain this information.
