University Requirements for Connecticut Community College Transfers

American Political Foundations	3	HIS 201, POL 111 (Education majors must take HIS 201)
Communication Skills	6	ENG 200 & COM 173
Exercise Science	1	Take at SCSU (waived for students transferring 24 credits or more)
Fine Arts	3	ART 101, 102, MUS 101
Foreign Language	3	BS degree - second semester level required (FRE, ITA or SPA 102) BA degree – fourth semester level required (FRE, ITA or SPA 202)
Health	1	Take at SCSU
History of World Civilizations	3	HIS 101, 102
“L” Course (writing course)	9	Take at SCSU (transfer with 60+ credits, only need 2 “L” courses)
Literature	3	ENG 221, 222, 232, 262
Math	3-4	MAT 143, 146, 165, 230, 250(254) Requirement varies – see counselor for further information
*Natural Sciences, Group A	3-6	BIO 121, 122, EAS 102, OCE 101, AST 101, GLG 121, OR both BIO 211 & 212
*Natural Science, Group B	3-4	CHE 111, 121, PHY 121
*One natural science course MUST have a lab		
Philosophy	3	PHL 101, 111, 131, 151 (Education majors take at SCSU)
Social Sciences A	3	ECN 101, 102, GEO 101, POL 103, 111
Social Sciences B	3	ANT 101, 105, PSY 111, SOC 101, 201 (Education majors take PSY 111)

The chart is just a guide for using Connecticut Community College courses to complete University and Major Requirements for SCSU. There may be specific courses required to meet university requirements for a number of majors at SCSU. Use the SCSU catalog/web site to obtain this information.
