“L” Course (writing intensive)	9	Take at SCSU (transfer with 60+ credits, only need 2 “L” courses)
Literature	3	ENG 221, 222, 232, 262
Math	3-4	no equivalent at MCC
Natural Sciences, Group A	3-6	BIO 211
Natural Science, Group B	3-4	CHE 121
Philosophy	3	PHL 101, 111, 131, 151
Social Sciences A	3	ECN 101, 102, GEO 101, POL 103, 111

In addition to the University Requirements, Nursing students need to satisfy course prerequisites before they can be admitted to the Nursing program. Students must maintain a “C” or better in all prerequisite courses.
