Please note:

- Other courses may transfer to UCONN but may not meet the Gen. Ed. Requirements.

Competencies:

Second Language competency in a single foreign language, either one of the following:

1. 3 years of one language in High School
2. Completion of level 3 in one language (for students who began a language in middle school)
3. Completion of intermediate level 2 (for students who have not completed 3 years of one language in high school) ***This rule only applies to students planning to enroll in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences or the School of Business**
4. Completion of elementary level 2 (for students who have not completed 3 years of one language in high school) *** This rule applies to students planning to enroll in the Schools of Engineering, Fine Arts, Education, and the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources**

Expository Writing

1. ENG 101 and ENG 110
Will also need 3 “W” courses – ENG 200 can be taken to complete a “W”

Quantitative Reasoning

1. 3 “Q” courses at least 1 must be in Math or Statistics
MAT 146, 148, 158, 165, 186, 230, 250(254), 256, 268, 272, 285, 287
(CHEM 121, 122, PHY 110, PHY121, 122)

Content Area 1 – Arts + Humanities

1. For Bachelor of Arts- 5 courses; including at least 1 from each area below
2. For Bachelor of Science- 4 courses; including at least 1 from each area below
 - A) **ARTS** - ART 101, 102, 206; MUS 101, COM 154
 - B) **LITERATURE** – ENG 114, 221,222,232, 245, 246, 262
 - C) **HISTORY** – HIS 101, 102, 121, 122, 201, 202, 215, 216
 - D) **PHILOSOPHY** – PHL 101, 111, 131

Content Area 2 – Social Sciences

1. 2 courses from 2 different academic areas

ANT 101, 105 **ECN** 101, 102 **GEO** 101, 111

POL 103, 111 **PSY** 112 **SOC** 101, 201, 220

Content Area 3 –Science + Technology

1. **For BA** – 2 courses from 2 different academic units; at least 1 of which must be a lab course

Lab courses: **BIO** 105, 121, 122 **CHEM** 111, 121, 122

PHY 110, 121, 122 **GLG** 121

Non-lab courses: **EVS** 100 **OCE** 101 **AST** 101 **PSY** 111 (will fulfill non-lab science requirement if **PSY** 112 is completed)

2. **For BS** – 1 sequence from **A, B and C**, plus 1 course from **D**

a) **CHEM** 121 + 122

b) **MAT** 250(254) + 256

c) **PHY** 221 + 222

and

d) **BIO** 121 or 122

Content Area 4 – Diversity and Multiculturalism/International

1. 2 courses; at least 1 of which must cover an international “I” area of study

ANT 105 (I) **HIST** 215 **SOC** 220

POL 103(I) **GEO** 111(I)
